

COMBINING A STATE LAW LABEL AND THE TB 117-2013 WITH CHEMICAL STATEMENT

Note: Law Label is not to scale

IABFLO has agreed that the state law label and the TB117-2013 with chemical statement flammability label may be printed on the same piece of material, provided that they are separated by a bold, black line. All formatting requirements still apply.

The two labels may be arranged either side-by-side or one above the other. If the labels are printed side-by-side, then the state law label must go on the left and the TB117-2013 chemical statement label on the right, separated by a vertical, bold, black line. If the labels are printed one above the other, then the state law label must go on top and the TB117-2013 chemical statement label on the bottom, separated by a horizontal, bold, black line. The choice is a company's to make. Both scenarios are illustrated below:
