





# DOMESTIC MATTRESS ALONE AND WITH A FOUNDATION FLAMMABILITY LABEL FOR 16 CFR 1633




# IMPORTED MATTRESS ALONE AND WITH FOUNDATION FLAMMABILITY LABEL FOR 16 CFR 1633






# LAW AND CFR 1632 FLAMMABILITY LABEL FOR A MATTRESS AND MATTRESS PAD

THE LAW LABEL EXAMPLES FEATURED BELOW FOLLOW THE SAME FORMAT AS THE BEDDING LAW LABEL SHOWN ON PREVIOUS PAGES. PLEASE REFER TO THAT LABEL FOR INFORMATION ON ADDITIONAL, SPECIFIC FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS.



While mattresses are required to meet both federal flammability standards of 16 CFR 1632 AND 1633, a mattress pad is required only to meet 16 CFR 1632. A mattress pad is defined as a thin, flat mat or cushion, and/or ticking filled with resilient material for use on top of a mattress. This definition includes, but is not limited to: absorbent mattress pads, flat decubitus pads and convoluted foam pads which are totally enclosed in ticking. This definition excludes convoluted foam pads which are not totally enclosed in ticking.

If a mattress pad contains a chemical fire retardant, it shall be prominently, conspicuously and legibly label with the letter "T" and with care instructions provided.

Each mattress pad shall bear a permanent, conspicuous label containing the month and year of manufacture and the location of the manufacturer. Since date information and the manufacturer's name are already included on the required 16 CFR 1633 label, for mattresses, that label satisfies this requirement of the CFR 1632 regulation. \* California does not require net weight of filling materials for a mattress pad but does for a pad. Contact California as to how your product qualifies.

Note: This product containing a flame retardant chemical must contain additional instructional labeling for the care of the product so as when cleaning such product the process or chemicals does not causes deterioration of the flame resistance.

All mattress pads which contain a chemical fire retardant shall be labeled with precautionary instructions to protect the pads from agents or treatments which are known to cause deterioration of their flame resistance. Such labels shall be permanent, prominent, conspicuous, and legible.

- (2) If a mattress pad contains a chemical fire retardant, it shall be prominently, conspicuously, and legibly labeled with the letter "T".
- (3) Each mattress or mattress pad subject to the Standard shall bear a permanent, accessible, and legible label containing the month and year of manufacture and the location of the manufacturer. (See § 1632.1(i) of the Amended Standard.)
- (4) The information required on labels by this section shall be set forth separately from any other information appearing on such label. Other information, representations, or disclosures, appearing on labels required by this section or elsewhere on the item, shall not interfere with, minimize, detract from, or conflict with the required information.
- (5) No person, other than the ultimate consumer, shall remove or mutilate, or cause or participate in the removal or mutilation of, any label required by this section to be affixed to any item.
