

UNIFORM LAW LABELS

USA LABELING STANDARDS - APPAREL (JACKETS, VESTS, BOOTS, etc.)

Filled clothing does not require the complex law tag label needed for bedding products. However, they must have a sewn-in label.

LABELING RULES

Any filled clothing, such as jackets, must have a sewn-in label. An example of the correct sewn-in label is:

WHITE GOOSE DOWN
(Minimum 75% Down)

A down/feather jacket with tested content of 65% down should be labeled:

DOWN & FEATHERS
65% Down
35% Waterfowl Feathers

LICENSE TO SELL FILLED CLOTHING IN THE USA:

If you sell, offer to sell (catalogue or internet), distribute, manufacture, or import filled clothing in the USA and these products are shipped to any Utah location, **you must license with the State of Utah.** Please see the attached application or contact:
